4 First Selection Committee meeting

The Selection Committee appointed by the Dean, met for the first time on 18th September 2019 to evaluate the CVs of candidates and determine the date of interviews and selection procedure.

The CVs of 9 candidates were introduced to the Selection Committee ([REDACTED] Kari Hemminki).

The first task of the Selection Committee was to evaluate fulfilment of formal requirements, such as:

- sending the application at latest by 5th September 2019
- sending the application via email address personalista@lfp.cuni.cz

The Selection Committee proceeded in accordance with the Code for selection procedure at Charles University, Project Grant Agreement, the European Charter for Researchers and the Code of Conduct for the Recruitment of Researchers, and properly and honestly evaluated all CVs submitted to the selection procedure.

On the basis of the submitted documents, the Selection Committee decided that, due to failure to meet the formal requirements of the application and failure to meet the requirements stated in the advertisement, 7 candidates will be excluded from further participation in the selection procedure, namely: [REDACTED]

The Selection Committee decided to invite 2 candidates for an interview [REDACTED] and Mr. Kari Hemminki), which will take place on 16th October 2019 at the Biomedical Center in Pilsen.

The Selection Committee also decided that the ballot for the selection procedure would be prepared in English for greater transparency and possibility to give candidates feedback on the outcome of the oral interview.

The interview invitation included the evaluation criteria, the interview schedule, and the full project Grant Agreement text was sent to the candidates as an attachment so that they could get a closer look at the content of the project.

Candidates were invited for the personal job interview and negotiations about the ERA Chair position by email sent on 18th September 2019. The confirmation of the attendance should have been sent no later than 30th September 2019 by emailing on personalista@lfp.cuni.cz. Both candidates confirmed their availability to participate on 16th October 2019. Also a delegate of the European Committee was invited to join.

In the meantime there was time for candidate's questions on the position after reading the project proposal, sending them at latest by 07th October 2019. In accordance with equal opportunities policy, we shared the received questions and answers with other applicants.

On 9th October 2019 Mr. Michele Tavecchio asked for the possibility of a Skype interview. After the committee consideration it was accepted as a possible solution which is following the principles mentioned in the project proposal. So the Skype address and time schedule were sent to him.

5 Personal job interview

The interview was held on 16th October 2019 in BC in Pilsen. The programme was set as following:

Each interview consisted of these points:

- 1) Informal conversation with committee members
- 2) Question and answer session
- 3) Project explanation
- 4) Candidate's plan and strategy for fulfilling the project role

Each candidate was during the interview informed about:

- the content of the project
- job description
- working conditions and labour terms in the Czech Republic
- the European charter for researchers

The evaluation criteria for each candidate were the same, as follows:

- i) managerial experience;
- ii) international collaboration ;
- iii) leadership of scientific projects;
- iv) scientometric indicators;
- v) experience with research group or research programs leadership;
- vi) experience with doctoral and post-doctoral mentoring
- vii) current scientific activity in genomic cancer research and competence for DNA sequencing and related bioinformatics

The Selection Committee proceeded in accordance with the Code for selection procedure at Charles University, Project Grant Agreement, the European Charter for Researchers and the Code of Conduct for the Recruitment of Researchers. Members of the committee voted in writing, secretly and anonymously through ballots.

On the basis of the interviews with candidates, documents sent by each candidate and the result of secret vote of committee members, the selection committee decided on the order of candidates as follows:
